

<u>Lake Band Parent Volunteer</u> Code of Conduct and Policies

- *There are not any specific assignments to a specific group of students; all chaperones help with all students as needed, unless specifically directed by a director.
- *Parent volunteers are to set a proper example for students by exhibiting model behavior. Treat the directors/staff with respect, treat the students with respect, treat the other chaperones and parents with respect, and finally treat other bands/opposing teams with respect. Please refrain from sharing personal opinions regarding the students, other parents, the directors, or any divisive issue. Band parent volunteers should set a good example in regard to conduct, language, and appropriate dress.
- *All disciplinary actions are to be referred to and handled by the directors only. The students know to give a parent volunteer the same respect as a teacher, but if there is any situation where you feel you have not been shown that level of respect, please do not get into a verbal or physical confrontation with the student. Please report this issue to the directors as soon as possible.
- *Parent volunteers are not to administer any medications, including pain relievers, such as Advil or Tylenol, to students. All medications to be administered to students must have been included on the student's medical form.
- *In compliance with the Lake Local School District policy, there will be no use of tobacco (of any form), vape, alcohol, drugs or inappropriate language where students are, will be, or can be present. They should also not be done around other band parent volunteers or at any time while volunteering.
